

VISITOR RESTRICTIONS MAY BE IN PLACE

For all staff **Droplet precautions**

in addition to standard precautions

Before entering room/care zone



Perform hand hygiene



Put on surgical mask

Put on protective eyewear

Perform hand hygiene





Remove mask and dispose of mask



Leave the room/care zone

Perform hand hygiene

What else can you do to stop the spread of infections?

- Consider patient placement
- Minimise patient movement
- Appropriate bed allocation. \bullet



Remove protective eyewear

Perform hand hygiene

At doorway prior to leaving room/care zone

Perform hand hygiene



- Perform hand hygiene before and after touching a patient or their surroundings
- Use personal protective equipment (PPE)*
- Use respiratory hygiene and cough etiquette
- Use aseptic technique
- Use and dispose of sharps safely
- Perform routine environmental cleaning and maintain a clean and safe healthcare environment
- Clean and reprocess reusable patient equipment
- Handle and dispose of waste safely
- Handle and dispose of used linen safely

*When used as part of **standard precautions**, PPE protects against probable exposure to blood and body substances. When used as part of transmission-based precautions, PPE serves as a barrier to specific means of transmission of infectious agents.
