You are invited to provide feedback to the Commission, addressing all or any of the following questions. Your input will help shape the standard.

Introduction

The National Pathology Standard has been developed to protect the public from harm and improve the quality of pathology services by describing a nationally consistent safety and quality framework. The Commission consulted with the pathology sector, consumers, professional bodies, jurisdictions, and government agencies to develop the standard.

Submission questions

1. Will the actions provide a robust safety and quality framework?
2. What safety and quality issues are not addressed in the standard?
3. Which actions need changes to the language to improve the clarity?
4. Are there areas of duplication or redundancy that could be removed?
5. Will the standard enable pathology practices to focus on their risks and outcomes?
6. Is your pathology practice ready to implement the standard?
7. Will the standard improve pathology testing safety and quality?
