

This practice takes part in MedicineInsight



MedicineInsight is a national primary care data program run by the Australian Commission on Safety and Quality in Health Care.

MedicineInsight collects and analyses non-identifiable patient information from general practices across Australia, to compare and discover trends in health care diagnosis, treatment and outcomes of patients.

This practice sends information such as age, gender, medical history and lifestyle from patients' medical records to the MedicineInsight program.

The information the practice sends cannot be identified. This means the practice does not provide names or any other information that may identify patients to MedicineInsight.

The practice will automatically send your non-identifiable information to MedicineInsight unless you tell the practice that you do not want it to be sent.

In some cases your general practice may be able to re-identify patient information provided in reports to assist them in providing better care to you – only your practice has the ability and authority to do so. For example this could take the form of encrypted numbers that a general practice can convert to a list of patients with a respiratory illness who are overdue for a particular medical test.

If you do not want this practice to send your information to MedicineInsight, you can opt out of the program and your information will not be used.

If you want to opt out, please ask the practice for a copy of the MedicineInsight opt-out form to complete and say that you want to opt out of the program. You can do this at any time, for any reason.
